WGF, Wilder Game Food Grain Sorghum was selected to accommodate the needs of upland birds (Quail, Turkey, Pheasant, and Prairie Chicken) and migratory birds (Ducks, Geese, and Dove). It produces a fall and winter food source that lasts. The red seed serves as a mold and rotting repellent during exposure to weather. Crop residue provides excellent low height ground cover. Wilder Game Food is a medium maturity heavy grain producer.
